The Law Library subscribes to a variety of databases that specialize in law and legal resources. Some are available through the Law Library; others require each student sign up and create personal usernames and passwords .

Below are three databases that require you to create your own usernames and passwords. The information required for signing is time sensitive. Please sign up as soon as possible. Registration is required for LRW and other Law School classes. Please make sure to use your Campbell Law email address when you sign up(.edu).

THOMSON REUTERS (WESTLAW)

Thomson Reuters--better known as WESTLAW--is one of the largest, most widely-used legal research databases, both for U.S. and international law. You will receive an email with your individual OnePass registration key from Thomson Reuters with sign up information.

LEXIS +

Like Westlaw, LexisNexis is also one of the largest and widely used legal research databases, especially for North Carolina practice materials. You will receive an email from Professor Weeks with sign up information.

CALI.ORG (COMPUTER ASSISTED LEGAL INSTRUCTION)

CALI stands for Computer Assisted Legal Instruction. It is a well-known database of tutorials on various law school topics that have been written by professors from law schools nationwide. You will receive an email from Professor Weeks with sign up information.
