### **Barristers Music - Liquid Pleasure**

- Band plays the whole time from 8:30-11:30, no breaks

  - Price: \$1,850
  - Red Bird Package (Up to 5 hours of music, Dance floor lighting, Uplighting)
- **All Around Raleigh DJ**
  - Price 1: "Private Event"
    - \$795 → DJ package for 4 hours
    - \$995 → Uplighting package
    - \$595 → Upgraded dance floor lighting
    - Total: \$2385
  - Price 2: "Corporate Event" (most likely us based on size and the venue space)
    - \$1195 → DJ package for 4 hours
    - \$395 → Upgraded Sound System (for events 350+)
    - \$995 → Uplighting package
    - \$595 → Upgraded dance floor lighting
    - Total: \$3180
