## **SBA Town Hall Meeting Notes**

February 1st, 2022 - 5:30 to 7:00 PM

Starting with pre-asked questions submitted via SBA email

- Question 1: What is SBA doing about the issue of diversity? There is a committee and they have had one event open to the public, but what else is SBA doing?
  - Niaya Diversity Committee chair answered this question
    - This is our second year since starting the committee
    - With last years limitations from COVID we could only do mostly virtual things
      - Releasing monthly statements
      - Legal films/articles about diversity related topics
      - Drafted diversity statement on website
    - This year we've had more freedom to do interactive/hands on events
      - Lunch and learn events
        - Have one in February coming up
        - Another one mid march/early april
        - Someone asked to know more about what Lunch and Learns are
          - SBA provides food
          - Ask about 10 questions
          - Prompt students to answer questions either in person or on index cards
          - The first one got a lot of great feedback. The theme was "feeling boxed in."
          - February's theme being a legal ally and will be moderated by professor Fields
          - Want to invite faculty/staff and just listen for them to absorb some of the feedback they hear
      - Acknowledging different months for different communities
      - Sending out newsletters
    - The school hired Russel McClain who is meeting with the faculty and working with them to improve our diversity issues
      - The school previously sent a link out for people for people to weigh in
      - He has workshops/discussions for students
      - Question → are we doing more with the faculty outside of Mr.
        McClain
        - If we have a specific issue, we can bring it up to the faculty and address it
        - We tried to hire someone for a permanent diversity position specifically and last year it was not possible
        - Hopefully in the future, they will hire someone

- Question → can people work with the diversity committee that are non-SBA?
  - Yes, Diversity is an "Ad hoc" committee which means we can let people who are not in SBA join the committee
  - SBA has the discretion
  - Not likely going to extend it to 50 or more people but if there are people who are very seriously interested
- Question 2: Why are the meetings and the entire SBA agenda focused solely on student life events?
  - o Melvin Vice President responded
    - That's what we have in our power to do as SBA
    - We are limited to what we can do
    - We were just allowed to have in person events again
    - We've put more focus on having events for student body as a whole to relieve stress and build community
    - We are trying to reach out to as many people as we can
  - o Christina Treasurer
    - We get two hours a month to plan some of the biggest events for our school
    - We have a committee to do the work but the committee decisions have to be approved by council
    - Its apart of the process of what we do
  - Caroline President
    - Most of the planning is done in private meetings
- Question 3 → Why do members of SBA not want the help, ideas, input, and participation of students not in SBA?
  - We do want feedback
  - The context of our last meeting may have been confusing, but we definitely want feedback. BUT we want leadership roles to be SBA members because we are voted in.
  - The comments in last weeks agenda pertained to a specific vote
  - We absolutely want someone to come to your SBA reps, not a third party
  - Purpose of SBA is to represent and speak for the student body

## Questions added within the meeting

- Do we have a "threshold" for going back to online school?
  - Administration is likely not going to do another hybrid situation
  - When there was a vote in 2020, the majority of students wanted to be in person
  - Not aware of a particular threshold
  - o If main campus goes online, we likely will but we are not sure
  - The original decision was main campus and they did not really consider us when going online
  - We think they forgot about our start date

- Some people feel scared to bring concerns because they feel like SBA members are taking it as an attack
  - Please bring your concerns to SBA
  - Virtual suggestion box is always open if you want to leave an anonymous comment
  - Reach out to people that you are comfortable with if you don't feel like you can talk to a specific person

  - We are doing a bulletin board with student reps info
  - Add office numbers
    - We only have one office in the student offices its caroline office
    - Across from the printer on floor 2
- Where is the virtual suggestion box?
  - Bottom of week ahead email every week
