Postgraduate Surgical Residency

This 12-month surgical residency program will provide intense training in the perioperative and operative management of patients. PA Residents will develop critical thinking and surgical assistant skills throughout the year. Residents can expect to gain the fundamentals of surgical care through both didactic and clinical settings in a multitude of surgery subspecialties to best prepare you for a career in surgery. Surgical rotations include, but are not limited to, general surgery, surgical oncology, vascular, thoracic, cardiac, trauma, ICU and electives. Monthly skills labs and periodic assessments are utilized to fine tune skills and measure improvement over time.

Postgraduate Critical Care Residency

This 12-month residency places physician assistants in a structured educational environment that provides opportunities to develop proficiencies in ICU care consistent with best practices and guidelines established for the critical care medicine subspecialty. PA residents will attend lectures and work within structured ICU teams to achieve the knowledge, skills and abilities necessary to practice critical care medicine as a member of the multidisciplinary care team. Critical Care rotations include medical, surgical, neuro, cardiac, cardiac surgery and burn ICUs; emergency department; infectious diseases, renal consult services and electives. PA residents successfully completing the program will be competent in the multi-disciplinary care of acute and critically ill ICU patients.
