What is this program about/What are the benefits?

- One or two year full-tuition and fees scholarships
- 3 years active duty commitment + 5 years inactive reserve commitment
- Monthly stipend throughout school
- HUGE opportunities for leadership and career growth
- Guaranteed job post graduation
- Huge community of amazing individuals working alongside you
- Opportunities to travel and gain new, unique experiences

What is the application process like for HPSP?

1. Reach out to a local health professions recruiter
2. Fill out an application
 - a. including a few essays, 3 letters of recommendations (one from a professor), and an updated copy of your CV
3. You will fill out quite a bit of paperwork and sign many documents
4. Once your documents and application are approved, you will go to MEPS (military entrance processing station) in Raleigh
 - a. One afternoon extensive medical appointment
5. You will be assigned an interview date
6. Upon acceptance, you will be processed to commission
7. Once you graduate pharmacy school, you will attend Commissioned Officer Training [COT] and begin working as a Captain

What was my HPSP timeline like?

- Started the application summer of 2021
- Attended MEPS first week of August 2021
- Interviewed in September 2021
- Accepted November 2021
- Commissioned March 2022
- Scholarship started August 2022
- Attending COT Summer 2024
