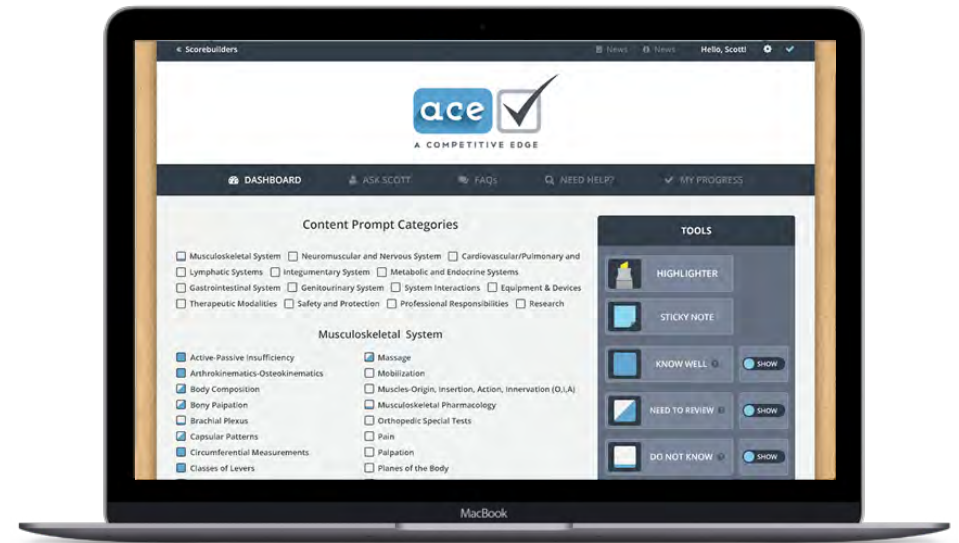

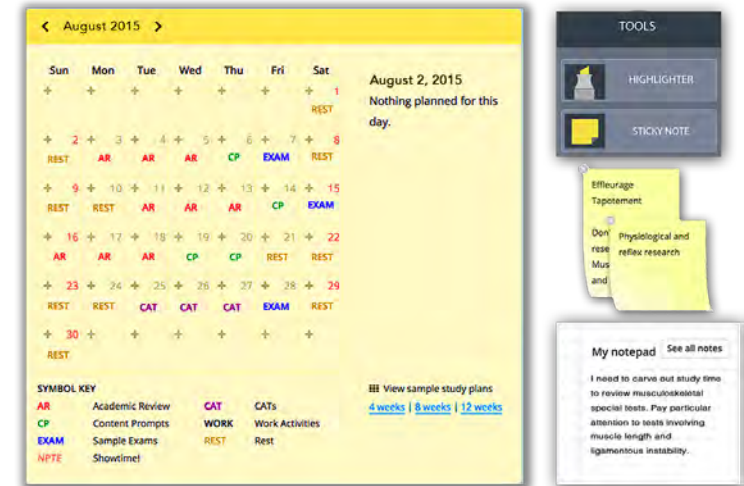


Challenging Multiple Choice Questions

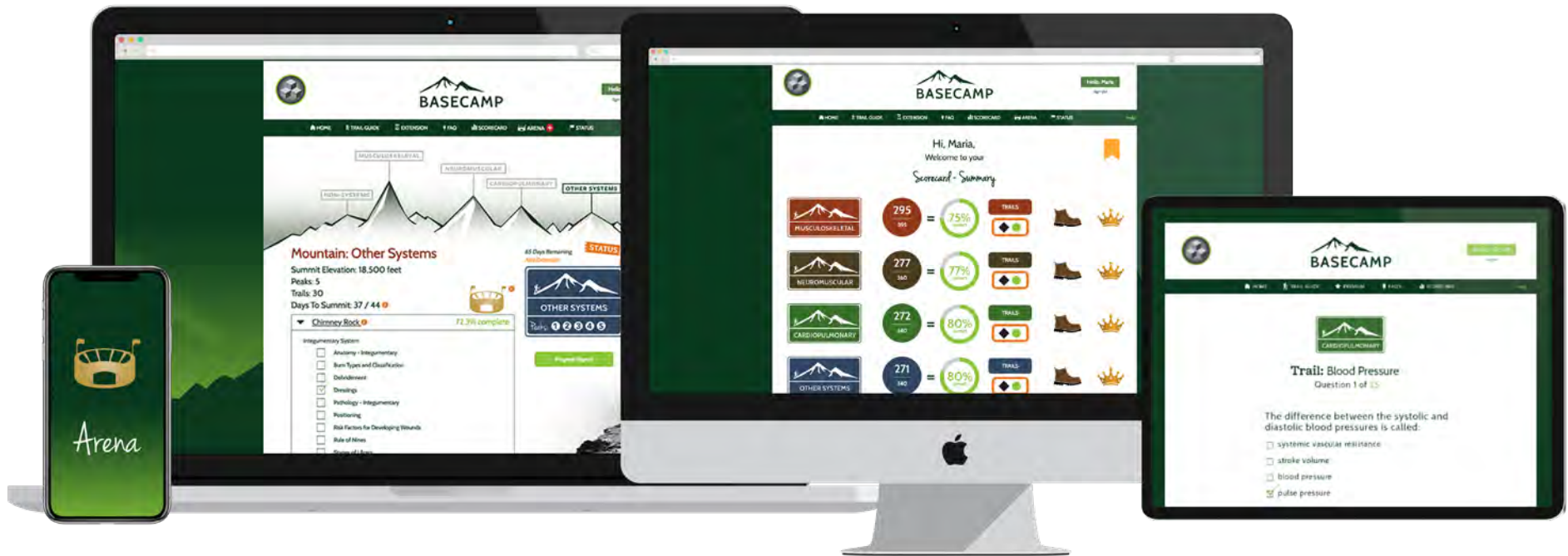

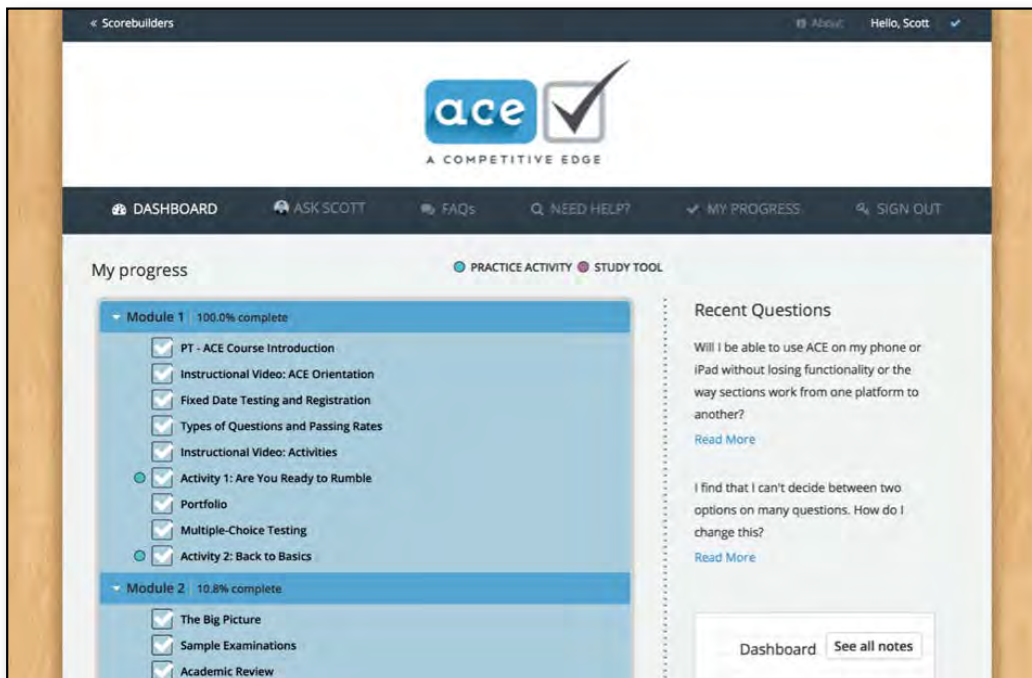
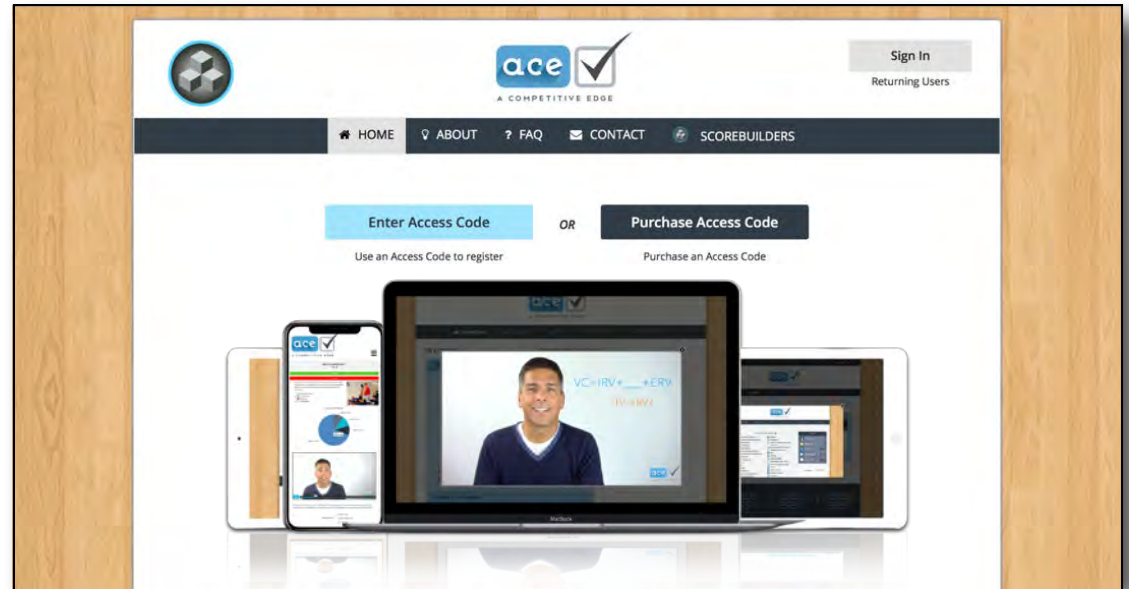


Chart a Course for Success

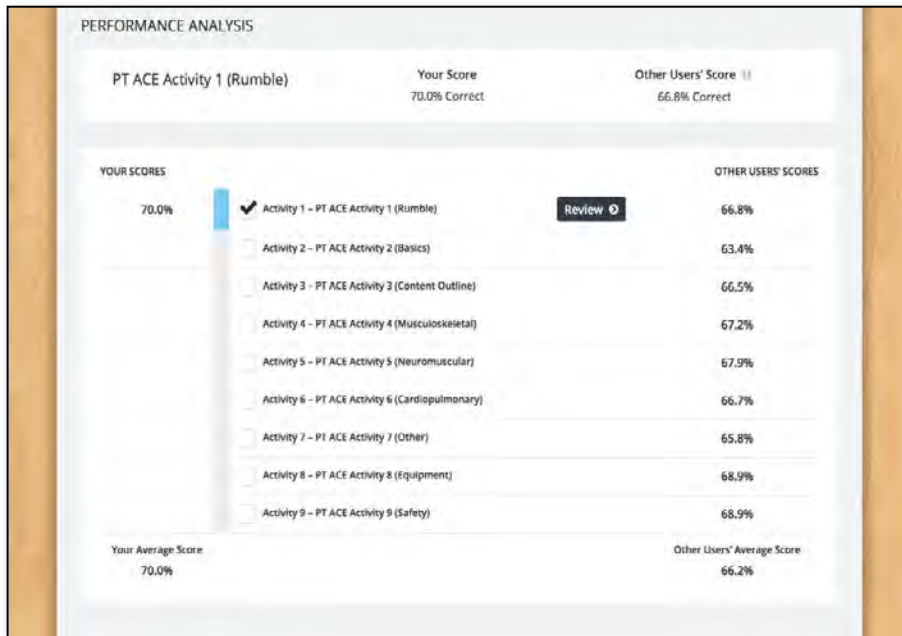
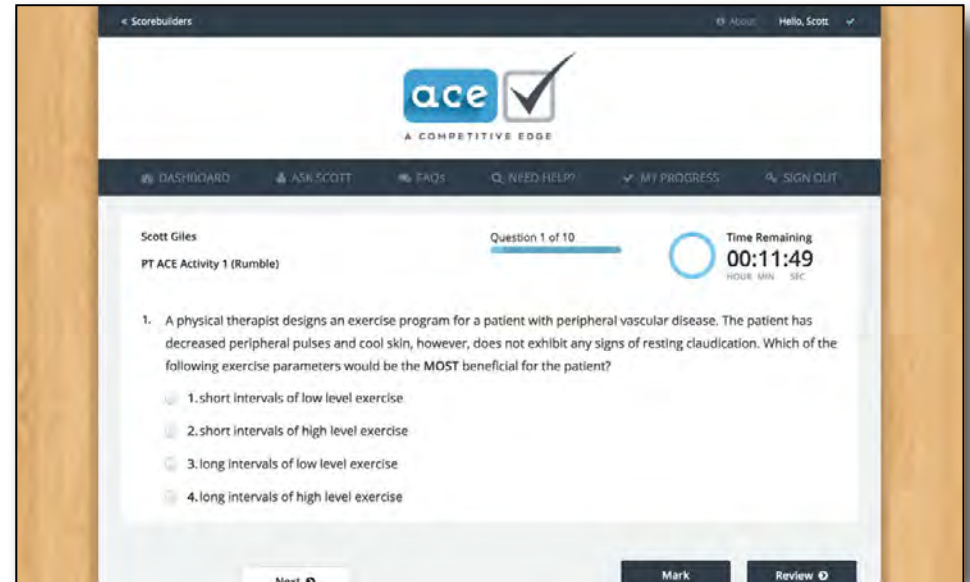

Sample Questions

ACE offers nine unique activities designed to assess a student's knowledge in a given system (e.g., musculoskeletal, neuromuscular) or non-system (e.g., physical agents, safety) area. The activities use current exam functionality including selected sorting options and a strikeout feature.



Performance Analysis

After completing an activity, students can determine their percentage correct and compare their results to the mean score of all other ACE users.

Students can review the answers to each question and see which questions were answered correctly and incorrectly.

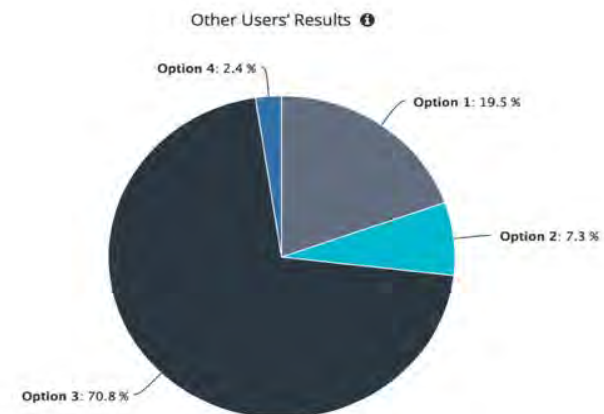
Advanced Analysis

Students can elect to examine a given question in more detail. The pie chart shows the percentage of all ACE users selecting each of the available options. This type of detail is critical to assist students to refine decision making skills.

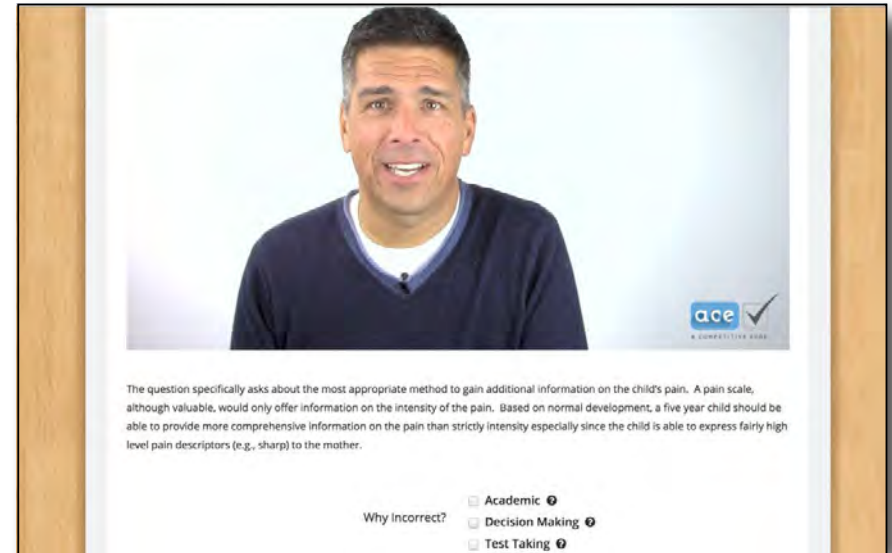
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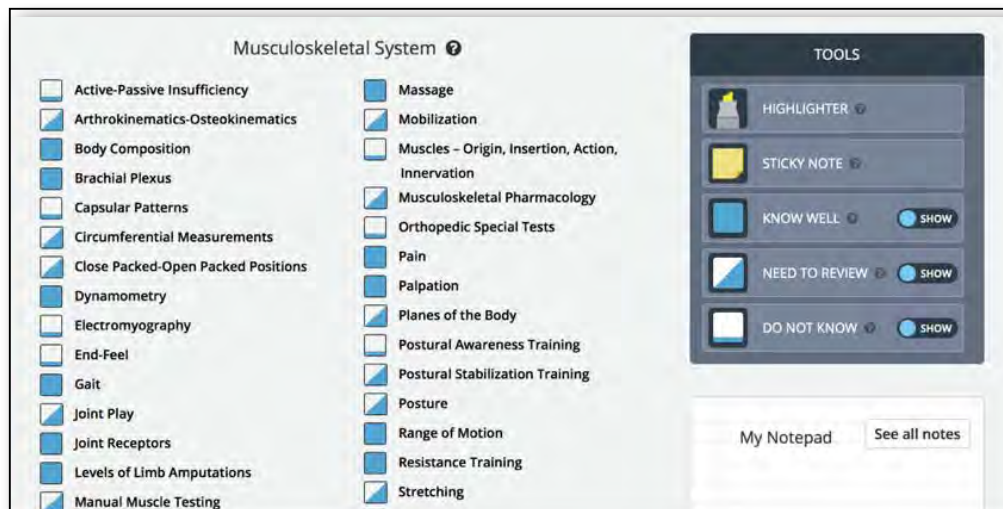
Video Explanations

Students can elect to watch a video explanation for the correct and each of the incorrect options or read a brief narrative. Questions answered incorrectly are classified as either an academic, decision making or test taking mistake. The percentage of mistakes in each area is recorded in the performance analysis section. **ACE** presents specific remedial strategies for addressing each type of mistake.



Active Study Tools

ACE includes three active study tools that are designed to complement traditional passive study tools. Selected screenshots from the study tools are pictured below. Students receive video guidance on how to utilize each of the study tools. The study tools allow students to rate their competence in specific academic content areas using mastery cubes. Sorting functions allow students to quickly identify topics requiring remediation.



Improve Flexibility with Essential Academic Content

Students are able to explore each academic content area in greater detail and then designate each topic as a strength or a weakness. The collective number of strengths and weaknesses help inform the student about their current mastery level.

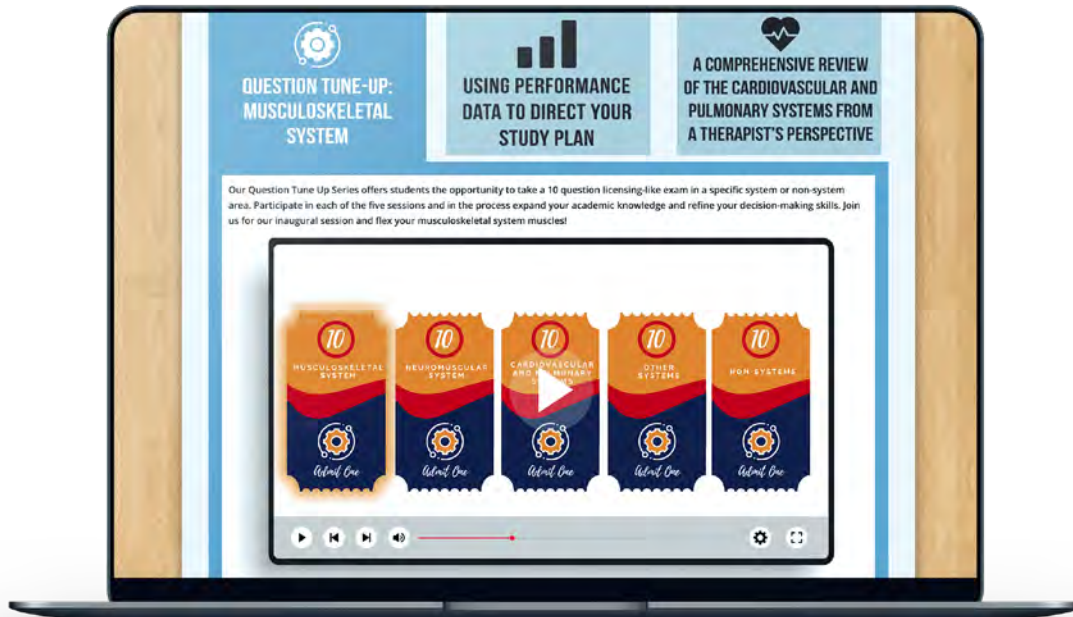
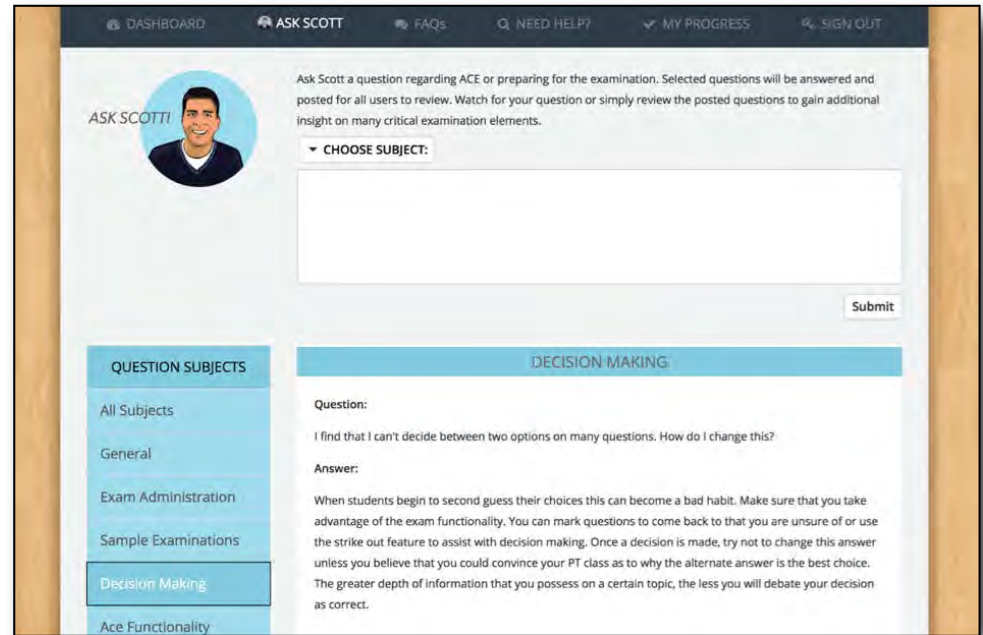

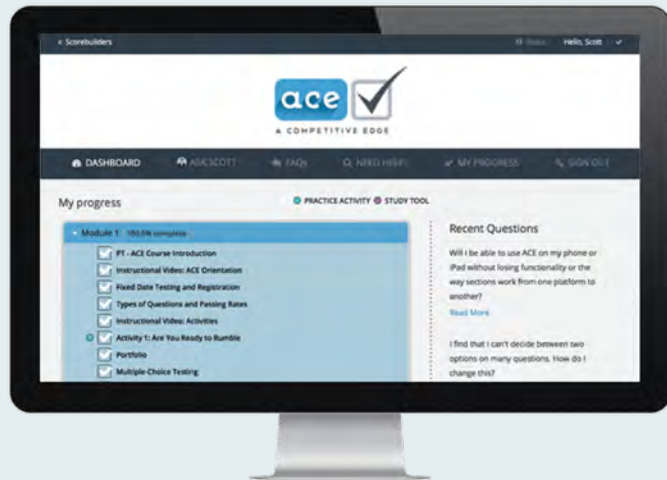
