

Students of the Campbell University College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences (CPHS) and the School of Osteopathic Medicine (CUSOM) are required to carry a health insurance plan that provides coverage while in the state of North Carolina.

CPHS and CUSOM students are required to either waive or enroll in the student insurance plan each year.

International students are required to participate in the student insurance policy and are encouraged to enroll online.

The 2021-2022 student insurance plan is provided by Blue Cross Blue Shield NC (BCBS). The online portal to waive or enroll is open July 1 through August 31.

A charge for illness insurance is billed to all student accounts and will only be removed if an approved waiver is submitted online by August 31. Students who do not submit an approved waiver by August 31 will be enrolled in and held financially responsible for the insurance plan.

CUSOM students: entering your insurance info in CastleBranch does NOT fulfill this waiver requirement. The Bursar's Office does not have access to the CastleBranch system.

Students without coverage need to enroll themselves online as soon as possible to prevent delays in receiving an insurance card. BCBS will enroll students who have not submitted a waiver at the close of the portal, but this will not be finalized until late September.

Students currently enrolled in the Campbell University health insurance must renew by submitting an enrollment form online if they wish to continue coverage.

This is an annual plan with coverage effective August 1, 2021 through July 31, 2022.

Students who enroll in the University plan may also insure any dependents for an additional cost paid directly to BCBS.

- Visit www.campbell.edu/bursars-office/ and follow the links under Student Resources to access the BCBS Student Blue portal.
- Click the "Request Waiver" button.
- Enter your information and follow the rest of the steps to waive.
- The charge will be removed from your account if your waiver is approved.

Need health insurance?

- Visit www.campbell.edu/bursars-office/ and follow the links under Student Resources to access the BCBS Student Blue portal.
- Click the "Enroll for Coverage" button.
- Enter your information and follow the rest of the steps to enroll.
- The charge of \$1,316 will remain for fall. A charge of \$1,843 will be billed to your account in the spring.

Need to add a dependent?

- Add them while enrolling yourself in the coverage using the BCBS portal.
- Coverage premiums for dependents will be paid directly to BCBS via a bank draft.
