Review Criteria:

Criteria I: Need

- a. The extent of the current and anticipated need(s) of the local community have been carefully identified and are addressed by the proposed activity.

Criteria II: Innovation

- a. The proposed project contains original, innovative, or creative aspect(s).

Criteria III: Best Practices

- a. Best practices for community engagement are incorporated into the plans for implementation of the activity.

Criteria IV: Feasibility and Sustainability

- a. Logistical needs and strategies for successful implementation are clearly articulated.
- b. The activity is feasible to implement within a defined timeframe and plans to facilitate sustainability of the activity are considered.

Criteria V: Impact

- a. The proposed goals and outcomes are clearly defined.

Criteria VI: Resources

- a. The extent of collaboration and coordination with other health care providers, community members, and/or other stakeholders are addressed in the proposal.
- b. The proposed budget is clear and reasonable for implementing the activity.
