

Student Recruitment - Duke PUMP Program:

The Paired Undergraduate Mentoring Program (PUMP) in Uronephrology provides undergraduate students (rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors) with exposure to research, skills-building and mentored research experiences in urology and nephrology. PUMP provides a paid summer research internship followed by 10 months of virtual and in-person professional development activities. College students receive \$7,000 for the 8 week summer program.

Additional Details:

- Summer research program working with junior mentor and senior mentor on a project designed for the mentee.
- Research presentation at the end of the 8 week summer research experience
- Year-round professional development seminars following the summer program.
- Opportunity to return for a second research summer next year
- The PUMP Program is committed to ensuring a diverse participant group. Individuals from underrepresented minority groups and/or meeting the NIH definition of disadvantaged who aspire to graduate training and careers in biomedical research are encouraged to apply.
