What we know

Two week trip – all dates subject to change

Depart RDU June 9; arrive Yerevan June 10-11

Depart Yerevan June 23; arrive RDU June 23 or 24

“Base Camp” Armenian Baptist Theological Seminary in Ashtarak

Double rooms, bathrooms

Dining room, meals provided – Armenian food

Internet access (usually), cell phone

At least one day in Yerevan

Likely 2 days in Gyumri

Teaching continuing education program one day

Clinic, possible orphanage visit

Visits to Baptist parishes

Patient care and education in churches, homes

Hotel housing when away from Ashtarak – not luxurious, but okay

Sightseeing during travels between sites

Driver, translators throughout trip

Hepatitis A and B vaccines
