You are invited to attend the 2023 National Osteopathic Student Caucus (NOSC) hosted by the Council of Osteopathic Student Government Presidents (COSGP), a council of the American Association of Colleges of Osteopathic Medicine (AACOM). We are thrilled to share that COSGP has partnered with the Student Osteopathic Medical Association (SOMA) this year to expand the reach of NOSC.

The NOSC takes place prior to the AOA House of Delegates, where the policy standards of the osteopathic medical profession are voted on by representatives from state societies, affiliate organizations, and student leaders. The NOSC creates a forum for students to voice their opinions and perspectives on resolutions that will have an impact on current and future osteopathic medical students, including resolutions regarding medical education, clinical education, and other pertinent matters. The combined involvement of COSGP and SOMA at this NOSC will provide increased opportunities for osteopathic medical students across the country. The NOSC is a closed event, so only osteopathic medical students will be allowed to participate. A student opinion will be formed after the NOSC so that student delegates to the AOA House of Delegates ensure that all of your voices are heard when it comes to health policy decisions.

The NOSC will be held on **July 20th from 6 to 9 pm CT** via Zoom, as well as in person at the Chicago Marriott. This hybrid event will further encourage unification of the voices of student leaders.
