## Submission Guidelines

- Abstract Submission Deadline = Monday, December 2, 2024, 11:59 p.m.
- Abstract Submission Link = <u>https://cuweb.wufoo.com/forms/w13gk3uw08cb58v/</u>
  - Abstract <u>must</u> be submitted before the poster acceptance letters for the event will <u>only</u>be provided upon the submission of the abstract.
- Poster Submission Deadline = Monday, December 16, 2024, 11:59 p.m. no exceptions
- Poster Submission Link = <u>https://cuweb.wufoo.com/forms/wufi44e0t6hkdx/</u>
  - Research posters for in-person participants will be printed at no charge (posters for remote participants will not be printed). Please ensure that **poster measurements within PowerPoint are set to 36" x 48"** (directions on how to set measurements are provided in the Poster Template).
- Abstract and Poster submission links will be deactivated after the submission deadlines.

## **Participation Requirements**

- 1. All sections of the Abstract Submission Form must be completed.
- 2. Poster must include a quality parameter (what you learned) and will be assigned to one of the 9 CMS categories.
- 3. Abstract and poster must include an <u>osteopathic element</u> related to either philosophy or treatment.
- 4. Abstract and poster must include at least one <u>faculty mentor or preceptor</u> for the case/project.
- 5. The primary author for the case/project must be a student.
- Additional group members can consist of faculty (MD, DO, PhD), residents (PGY1 5), or other students (MS1 MS4).
- Groups cannot exceed the <u>maximum number of 5 participants</u> (including the primary student author and required faculty mentor/preceptor). At least one resident per group must attend and present during the inperson/virtual competition event in February; attendance for all other group members is optional but all are welcome to attend.
