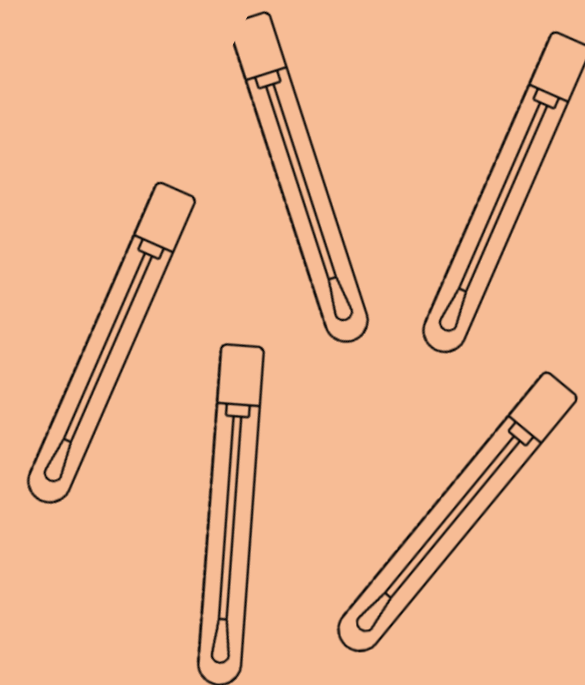


SWAB DRIVE

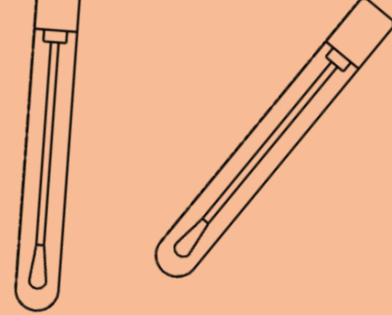

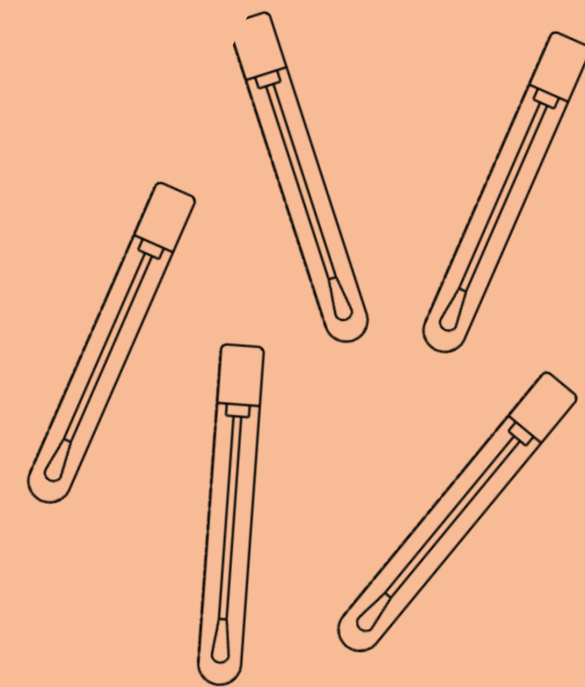

For Potential Donors

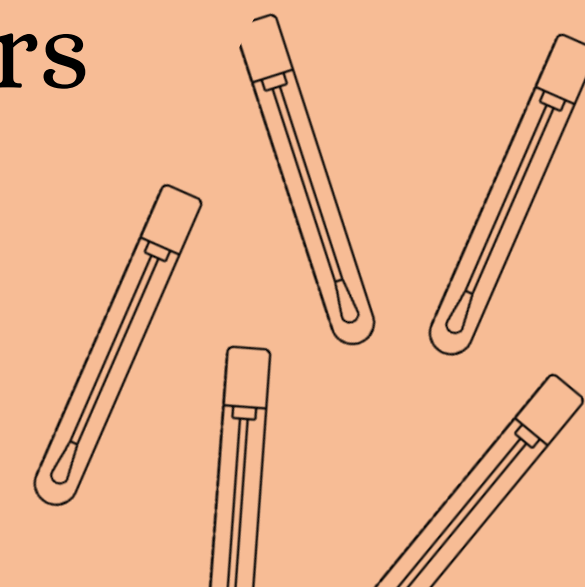
- Be between the ages of 18 and 55
