



Annual Convention

The ACOI Annual Convention is a great way for students to network with internists, current residents, and program directors. Student registration for the Annual Convention is free! In addition, ACOI offers student internal medicine clubs up to \$1,000 to help with costs for sending students to the convention. The annual convention includes sessions and networking opportunities geared to students.

Poster Contest

The ACOI Poster Competition hosted at the Annual Convention is a great way for students to present and compete at the national level! Categories include quality improvement, clinical research, bench research, and case submissions with prizes awarded in each category. The application process opens in the Spring.

Visiting Professor Program

The ACOI Visiting Professor program sends speakers specializing in internal medicine or one of its subspecialties to osteopathic medical schools. These lectures offer students the opportunity to hear from leaders in osteopathic internal medicine. Internal medicine clubs and departments work with ACOI staff to arrange virtual and in-person lectures.

Student of the Month Program

The ACOI Student of the Month program recognizes osteopathic medical students who are outstanding members of their medical schools and their communities. ACOI celebrates these outstanding students and recognizes their achievements. Student awardees have demonstrated their commitment to their communities through leadership, achievements in research, education, and personal achievement.

Student Lecture Series

ACOI hosts a monthly lecture series to help osteopathic medical students interested in internal medicine find success in their studies and future careers. Topics include passing board exams, succeeding in clinical rotations, developing and engaging in research, and more. Previous sessions can be watched for free on ACOI's YouTube Channel.

Mentor Program

Students can apply for a mentor through ACOI by completing an application on the ACOI website. ACOI mentors are doctors in the field who assist students in learning about residency, research, and subspecialty advice.
