

UC Health Critical Care Fellowship for Advanced Practice Providers (APPs)

APP Critical Care Fellowship

The APP critical care fellowship program with UC Health is a 12-month intensive training program in either the surgical critical care or medical critical care track. APPs in both tracks will gain experience in critical care medicine across a variety of intensive care units (ICUs) and consult services at the University of Colorado Anschutz Medical Campus in Aurora Colorado with rotation opportunities at sister hospitals-- Medical Center of the Rockies and Memorial Hospital.

The focus of this APP fellowship is to provide critical care didactic and clinical experience to both Physician Assistants and Adult Acute Care Nurse Practitioners across the continuum of care for critically ill patients. Didactic education will include a comprehensive training orientation, a variety of skills labs, simulation experiences, and biweekly education lectures. Clinical rotations may include surgical trauma ICU, cardiothoracic ICU, neurosciences ICU, burn ICU, medical ICU, trauma and acute care surgery, hospital medicine, infectious disease, renal, heart failure, pulmonary hypertension, hepatology, and palliative medicine services.

The fellowship is ideal for new graduates who wish to pursue a career in critical care medicine or practicing APPs who wish to change career focus. The goal of this fellowship is to help APPs transition smoothly into a career in critical care. Colorado is a welcoming state for all APPs. While outside of the hospital, fellows can easily enjoy breathtaking hikes, skiing, and bike riding in the beautiful Rocky Mountains.

Note: This program is not yet approved for formal CME credit. Program faculty plan to submit didactic curriculum to apply for 50 AAPA Category 1 CME credits from the AAPA Review Panel. The total number of credits is yet to be determined.
