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

# **How Common are APP Fellowships?**

#### Where are we now?

- Body of literature expanding rapidly in recent years
- New programs developed every year across country
- Multiple specialties: adult, pediatric, outpatient, inpatient, ED, surgical, trauma, critical care, transplant, etc.
- **Program accreditation** in existence for NP and PA programs
- **Positions are highly sought** → demand >>> available positions



#### Purpose

- AKA "Transition to Practice" program
- Provides structured experience necessary to optimize *role transition* to provider
- Improves job satisfaction and readiness to perform at high level in acute and critical care environments
- Results in more satisfied managers, administrators, and physician leaders
- Reduces provider turnover
- Fosters greater career opportunities, employee engagement, leadership opportunities

(Taylor et al, 2017; Schofield & McComiskey, 2014)



### Goals

- Enhanced, immersive, and comprehensive postgraduate critical care training
- Facilitate information sharing, and **networking** across institution
- Develop relationships and **collaboration** between specialties
  - Breaking down silos
- Serve as a platform for continuing education
- Serve as a method for professional development and teaching opportunities
  - APP Professional Development Program



# **Program Overview**

- Candidates: Any new graduate Acute Care Nurse Practitioner or Physician Assistant
- Number of candidates per cohort = 2
  - NP and/or PA
- Program: 12 months (~November November)
  - Hospital orientation / onboarding ~1-2 weeks prior
- Competitive salary and benefits awarded
- Hours: <u>Full</u> clinical schedule <u>PLUS</u> 1 dedicated didactic day per week
- 2-Part Curriculum: Clinical and Professional Development

# **Didactic Curriculum**

#### Clinical Curriculum:

- Monthly case studies, imaging rounds, and fellow presentations
- Weekly lecture content
- Skills training including (but not limited to): central line placement, arterial line placement, chest tube placement, bronchoscopy, ultrasound training, etc.
- Hands-on bedside echocardiography skills training
- Simulation experiences

#### Professional Development Curriculum

- Evidence Based Practice / Quality Improvement Project
- Written abstract for poster submission or creation of manuscript
- Seminars (2): Leadership; Crucial Conversations
- Mentorship and institutional professional development activities/committee involvement
- Other courses, tasks, and exercises as determined by director/coordinators in collaboration with APP Fellow

# **Clinical Curriculum**

#### **Rotations:**

Infectious Disease Thoracic and Cardiovascular ICU (TCVICU) Surgical Trauma ICU (STICU) Neuro ICU (NNICU) Medical ICU (MICU) Advanced Heart Failure Lung Transplant Abdominal Transplant Ultrasound skills, procedural training, and OR observation Elective time



### **Application Process**

#### **Application Requirements:**

- Completion of online application
- **G** Submission of Supporting Documentation
  - 500-word letter of intent describing why you wish to complete a postgraduate fellowship program in critical care
  - Academic transcripts
  - □ Three (3) letters of recommendation
    - (2) former preceptor or APP
    - ☐ (1) at applicant's discretion
  - Curriculum Vitae

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# Important Dates \*\*Subject to change from year to year

- Specific dates are listed on the job application
- Application closure: Late March
- Interview notifications: ~14 days after application closure
- The first round of interviews take place <u>virtually</u> in April-May
  - Each interview will take approximately 1-1.5 hours to complete.
  - Top candidates will be invited back for an in-person interview/share-day experience on a Fellowship Didactic Day (Fridays)
- All candidates will be notified of acceptance or denial by the last week of May
- Program start date: Varies year to year; ~November 15th; the first week is **Hospital Orientation** and **Fellowship Onboarding "Bootcamp**"



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#### Timeline for Dec, May, or August NP and PA Graduates


