The University of Florida's Physician Associate/Assistant Residency is an intensive 12-month post-graduate program designed to provide specialized training in the perioperative & operate management of patients.

## About the Program

The program, directly aligned with UF's ACGME-accredited General Surgery residency, provides a dynamic & nurturing training environment to ensure our resident's development as provider's in surgery. Residents will work alongside experienced faculty, advanced practice practitioners, & senior residents while developing a variety of in-demand skills. Graduates of the program have gone on to join UF Shands & other eminent programs as surgical providers. Our program actively recruits & helps our residents join UF Shands as full-time surgical PA's.

## Rotations & Didactics

Resident's have the opportunity to rotate through several core surgical rotations throughout the year, each 4-5 weeks in length, including 1-2 specialized elective rotations. Our residents are also provided weekly, protected didactic opportunities, with the ability to attain CME credits.

Resident benefits include health, life, & disability insurance at no cost to the resident, plus a competitive stipend, food stipend, educational stipend, three weeks of vacation leave, ATLS & ACLS certification, SCORE access, private gym access, etc.
