ELIGIBILITY

CURRICULUM

The curriculum comprises of mentored rotations within several subspecialties, didactic instruction, research, and direct clinical experience. Our fellows will gain experience in general gastroenterology, inflammatory bowel disease, esophageal disorders, motility disorders, hepatobiliary disease, general hepatology and management of hospitalized patients with gastrointestinal disorders.

GRADUATION

Upon graduation, fellows receive a certificate from Mayo Clinic School of Health Sciences documenting completion of a 12-month postgraduate fellowship in gastroenterology and hepatology. The certificate verifies that each fellow has completed all components outlined in the curriculum and achieved program competencies.
