- Intro to Home Delivery & Specialty Operations (1 month)

- Specialty Patient Care Intensive 2 (2 months, Q4)*

*Specialty areas for Intensives may include but are not limited to: Oncology, Dermatology, Gastroenterology, Rheumatology, Infectious Disease, Neurology, Home Infusion

- 340B program administration

- Specialty or Population Health Clinical Practice (year-long)


