Conceptualize, conduct, interpret, and present capstone research project at AMCP Nexus. Mentors appointed by AMCP Foundation to extend coaching. Paired with intern alumni in Internship Exchange Program.

All Pfizer programs expose interns to the pharmaceutical industry through Pfizer Payer Account Medical Leads or Oncology Field Medical Directors.

Managed Care Internship

Future leaders are placed in health plans and similar sites, where they learn about managed health care through exposure to population health via concepts such as formulary management, benefit design, medication therapy management, and adherence management.

Managed Care Oncology Internship

This program develops future leaders in managed health care with a focus on oncology. Working in specialty pharmacy or related business units within health plans and similar sites. Interns gain an appreciation of how managed care pharmacy principles are used to maximize health care resources and patient care outcomes.







Specialized Internship in **Health Outcomes**

Future leaders explore career options in health outcomes and pharmacoeconomics through exposure to research, measurement and applications to evidence-based decision-making. Working within the AbbVie Health Economics and Outcomes Research Department, interns will gain knowledge of the biopharmaceutical industry.



Internship in **Specialty Care**

Future leaders train under the supervision of specialty pharmacy experts and gain an understanding of managed care pharmacist roles, data analytics, and effective communication & leadership skills. The focus in this internship is learning how high-cost therapies can be optimally distributed and managed with patient education and adherence support through specialty pharmacy.
