- We're encouraging donors of all blood types to give with their whole hearts this month by scheduling and keeping their donation appointments.
- In February, severe winter weather and seasonal illnesses can make it difficult for the Red Cross to maintain a sufficient blood supply. Your donation can give hope and strength to patients in need.
- FOR DRIVES FEB. 1-29: All who come to give in February will receive a \$20 Amazon.com Gift Card by email! Terms and additional details can be found at <u>RedCrossBlood.org/Heart</u>.
- [FOR DRIVES WHERE POWER REDS WILL BE COLLECTED] Eligible donors with types O, B negative or A negative blood are encouraged to make a Power Red donation at this blood drive.
  - Power Red donors give a concentrated dose of red blood cells during a single donation, allowing them to maximize their impact.
  - During this type of donation, red blood cells are separated from other blood components, and the plasma and platelets are safely and comfortably returned to the donor.
