These Fellowships have a unique population health focus with vast research initiatives, projects, and the opportunity to obtain a teaching certificate. The fellowships offered by the University of Findlay College of Pharmacy are perfect for candidates that are interested in Telehealth, ambulatory care, administration, retail pharmacy, or a little bit of everything. The collaborations between The University of Findlay College of Pharmacy and Bon Secours Mercy Health and from The University of Findlay College of Pharmacy and Total Health Care Pharmacy allow for flexibility to tailor the experience to your interests.



These Fellowships are non-tenure, full-time positions, focusing on population health. They are a one-year fellowship position, with a second-year option to qualified candidates who meet the requirements of the sponsoring entities, Mercy Health or Total Health Care Pharmacy and The University of Findlay College of Pharmacy. The Fellow will operate primarily in the THC focusing on population health services, with occasional required travel to Mercy Health sites within Ohio and Kentucky or to Total Health Care Pharmacy. The remainder of the time will be spent with the University of Findlay College of Pharmacy faculty to gain an understanding of the context for population health and to develop expertise in developing, implementing, and analyzing population health strategies.
