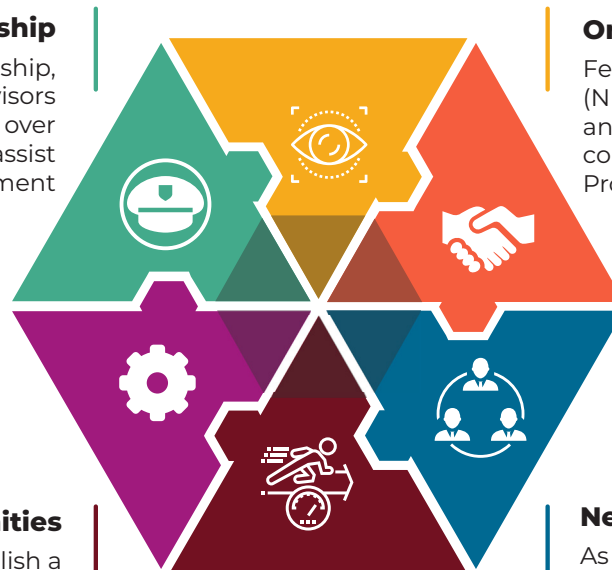

Application Timeline

- Initial phone interviews will be offered to eligible candidates on a rolling basis after a CV, a letter of intent, and 1 writing sample are received

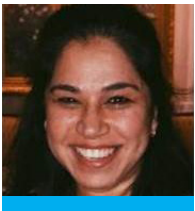

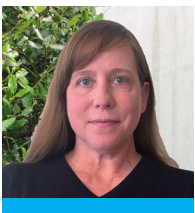

June Stevens, PharmD

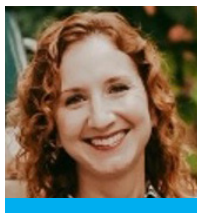

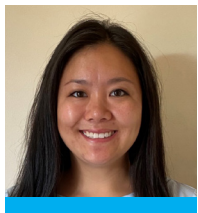
