

## **CLINICAL PHARMACIST – Oncology Services Division**

Practice or research specialty/focus of the position: Ambulatory Medical Oncology

- Participates in departmental and hospital committees and initiatives related to practice area.
- Contributes to student and resident education.
- Provides educational lectures and/or participates in research (Duke, State/Local, National).
- Works with peers to achieve division and departmental goals.
- Takes responsibility for personal and professional growth.
- Maintains familiarity with all departmental programs and works as integral part of the pharmacy team.

**Required or desired credentials or experience of applicants:** Pharm.D.; Three plus years of oncology clinical practice experience and/or PGY2 oncology residency preferred; BCOP preferred; CPP to be obtained within one year of hire.
