LEARNING AT THE MILWAUKEE VA IN AFFILIATION WITH UWM ORTHO RESIDENCY

Learning occurs as a 3-Part Approach that is flexible and adjusts to the resident's strength and weakness

1. Medbridge: Basic Pathway with clear outline of courses, quizzes, and practice test to monitor progress and learning throughout the year
2. In- House Didactic Module: Joint by Joint/Axial Spine modules with Case Studies and Research Articles, Weekly mentoring sessions, advanced training (TMD, Hand/Wrist, BFR, Dry Needling), 5 OCS Prep Practice Test
 - Optional: Academy of Orthopedic Physical Therapy -Residency Curriculum access
3. University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee PT Program A La Carte: Audit any lecture per resident desire, access to library, lab assistant in ortho class, cadaver lab, lectures to ortho class
